

Results ECCL 2024/2025

European Certificate for Classics

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With this small report, the 2024–2025 campaign of the European Certificates for Classics comes to an end. Students all over Europe have answered 40 multiple choice questions on texts about the stables of Augias, the battle of Thermopylae, the wedding of Peleus and Thetis or the death of Socrates. The number of participants has now recovered after the coronavirus slump. In many countries, such as Spain, Flanders and France, they

are well above the pre-epidemic figures. Malta and Israel (Associated Member) are taking part for the first time this year.

As usual, there have been two levels: Vestibulum (level 1, about 1–2 years of education) and IANUA (level 2, about 3–4 years of education). When obtaining a good result, the participants are awarded with a “medal”, which is a certificate of Euroclassica, of bronze, silver or gold. These results can be seen in the tables

under the text. At this moment, we are close to finishing the European exams 2025/2026. By the end of the summer, the representatives will receive an invitation for participating.
